Who's in charge?

Captaincy is used in a constructive auction to decide who is in a better position to determine the final contract. The captain is sometimes the opener and sometimes the responder. The captain is the partner of the first person to limit the hand both in shape and strength. It is important for both partners to recognize when captaincy occurs.
